Background

- Project Management & Systems Engineering processes are large scale complex engineered human systems
- People interacting produce emergent behaviors
- Unexpected behaviors create unwanted outputs
 - Schedule delays
 - Cost overruns



Background

- Physical systems can be tested and analyzed
- Human systems resist traditional research methods
 - True causes of failure can be obscure
 - Uncomfortable workplace topics are difficult to elicit
- Novel approaches may provide new insight for PM&SE challenges
 - Improv Theater



Improv



- Practitioner inhibitions can be removed in comedic settings
- Honest discovery, observation, and reaction is better than contrived invention (Close and Halpern)


Methods

- Scene framework development
 - Partnership with NASA and theater experts
- Recruit and train members of the Systems Engineering community
- Preliminary workshop
 - NASA 2019 Cost and Schedule Symposium
 - Video recording to assist analysis
- Post-show survey of actors and audience



Frameworks


- Developed by improv theater experts


Is improv an effective way to uncover hidden truths?

Uncovered Truths


Workshop

- People
 - "The improv shows the different personality types at NASA."
- Communication
 - "Hidden truths boil down to one importance of clear communication through project's life cycle."

- Communication
 - "Even though not all of us are engineers, we need to be included in technical discussions to better find cost estimating relationships."
